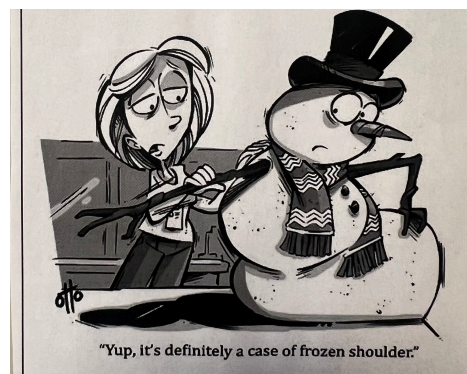

## Playoff Watch - In the Hunt

In the Colonie division, 1st National Bank cemented their spot in the cellar for this season with a loss to Team Mamba. 21 BOOM has clinched so 1st and 7th seed for the playoffs are now determined. The race for seeds 2-6 is still wide open as those teams are closely packed together and will be playing each other in the final weeks.

In the Albany division, surging Morris Ford kept its slim hopes alive to capture 1st place and claim the jacket with a resounding victory over 1st place Coldwell Banker. The division's top scorers went head to head with Bob Hanson scoring 45 and Glenn Richter scoring 43. Morris Ford now holds the tie breaker over Coldwell 2-1. ## By-Laws

The CSBL has a Constitution and By-laws to provide for stability, consistency, fairness & parity, and transparency. These can be viewed on the website under the League Administration tab. In the game between Labatt Blue and 518 Realty on Dec 16, although the intentions were good, league rules were not followed. 518 started the game with 5 players. At halftime, one player was unable to continue due to injury. League rules allow a team to continue to play with 4 players. However, a player from that week's Bye team was picked up from the stands and allowed to play and the game continued as a regulation game. That is not permitted. A team may only use a sub that is assigned by the Wait List Manager or the Commissioner. Captains may not contact or procure players to be a sub. At that point the game should have been declared a forfeit. The Board has reviewed the situation and declared the game a forfeit win for Labatt Blue. Individual player statistics will only be counted for the first half.
